OVERDOSE STATISTICS 6/1/19 - 6/30/19:



110 incidents



33 successful home visits*

*The outreach team made contact with a SUD, family/friend or both.



85% non-fatal

6% fatal

9% at-risk*

*A loved one reported this individual due to concern of potential overdose.

PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATE:

On July 6th, Plymouth County Outreach put out an alert for the towns of Plymouth, Carver and Wareham. In a 7 day period these three towns recorded 10 overdose incidents with 5 of them being suspected fatal overdoses.



Pco and it's partners want the public, especially individuals at risk for an overdose and their family and friends, to be aware of the increased risk of an overdose and what actions you can take.
