OVERDOSE STATISTICS 11/1/18- 11/30/18:



109 incidents



51 successful home visits*

79% non-fatal

6% fatal

15% at-risk*

*A loved one reported this individual due to concern of potential overdose.

Did you know that NARCAN typically wears off in 30-90 minutes and the person can re-overdose along with other complications?

For this reason, call 911 in the event of an overdose so the person can be monitored until they are medically cleared
