21% at-risk\*

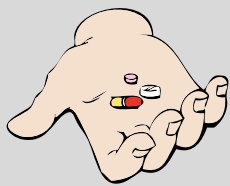

## PUBLIC HEALTH ALERT



Counterfeit medications can be almost identical to real Rx medications, making it nearly impossible to distinguish one from the other. In 2019, the DEA found that 27% of seized tablets Nationwide contained a lethal dose of fentanyl. **If you are taking medication you did not receive from a pharmacy, assume it is contaminated with fentanyl.** PCO can provide fentanyl test strips free of charge that will allow you to test your substances before use.
