## PUBLIC SAFETY ALERTS



We have continued to see a rise in fentanyl showing up in pressed pills marked as Adderall, Xanax, Oxycodone, and more. Please be extremely cautious and assume that any substance you did not purchase from a pharmacy has fentanyl in it. The DEA and its law enforcement partners are seizing deadly fake pills at record rates and has now identified counterfeit pills in all fifty states. If you are using a substance you did not get from a pharmacy, please, utilize fentanyl test strips.
