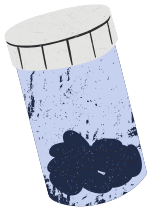
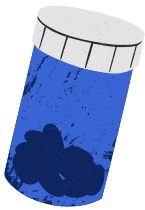

On Saturday, April 30th, Plymouth County Outreach in collaboration with the Plymouth Youth Development Collaborative, the Plymouth Area Prevention Collaborative, the Plymouth Police Department, and the Plymouth Fire Department will be hosting a drug take back day event at Plymouth North High school from 10:00am - 2:00pm. Stop by with your unused or expired prescription medications, sharps, and vapes to be disposed of safely! Free narcan, harm reduction supplies, resources, and snacks will be available.
