COMMUNITY NARCAN TRAINING

On Thursday, May 4th, PCO will be partnering with the Plymouth Youth Development Collaborative to host a community Narcan training! The training will take place at Plymouth Police Department located at 20 Long Pond Road in the training room on the left of the lobby from 5:30pm - 7:00pm. The training will include an overview of the PCO and Plymouth Youth Development Programs, how to respond to an opioid overdose, a presentation on talking to youth about substance use, and a Q&A on substance use disorder and recovery. Those in attendance will receive FREE Narcan!

DRUG TAKE BACK DAY!

On Saturday, April 22nd, PCO in collaboration with the Plymouth Youth Development Collaborative, the Plymouth Police Department, and the Plymouth Fire Department, will be hosting two Drug Take Back Day events from 10:00am to 2:00pm. The events will take place at two locations in Plymouth:

Cedarville Fire Department, Upper Parking Lot 2209 State Rd. Plymouth MA

Stop by with your unwanted or expired prescription medication, vapes, and sharps for safe disposal. During the event, PCO staff will be distributing free Narcan, Deterra kits, harm reduction tools, resources, and more! Staff at the Plymouth Police Department location will also be running Hidden in Plain Sight trainings for parents from 10am - 2pm in the PCO office located inside the Plymouth Police Department.
